Our Coaches...

Ford, Julia - Julia is a trained regional coach with 3 years of experience in the Canskate program, and 2 years with the Starskate program. One of her biggest milestones was achieving Skate Canada's Triple Gold status in Skills, Dance, and Artistic. While being committed to helping skaters learn valuable skills both on and off the ice, she is currently pursuing a degree in Science at the University of Alberta's Augustana campus with the intention to complete a masters degree in Pharmacy. Julia's coaching philosophy advocates for creating a safe and supportive community for skaters to feel uplifted and not only grow as athletes, but as individuals who understand the importance of goal setting and motivation. Being a coach has great meaning to Julia as she has experienced how the impact of a supportive coach and community have a positive lasting effect on a skater.

Gau, Jana - I began skating at the age of five, and it quickly became a true passion of mine. I skated with the Camrose Skating Club for 15 years while also training with various clubs in Edmonton. Following my competitive years, I transitioned into coaching and have now been coaching with the Camrose Skating Club for 22 years. Sharing my passion for skating with young athletes and witnessing their growth and achievements has been incredibly rewarding.

In addition to coaching, I am also a teacher in Camrose, currently teaching Grade Three at St. Patrick School. I have been teaching for 17 years, fostering a supportive and engaging learning environment for my students. During the spring and summer months, I also coach the Camrose Swim Club, where I have been involved for 24 years, helping swimmers develop both their skills and confidence in the water.

My personal skating achievements include earning the Quadruple Gold Award, having achieved Gold levels in Artistic, Skating Skills, Freeskate, and Dance. I have also achieved my Diamond Dance level.

Outside of teaching and coaching, I enjoy staying active through running, yoga, and paddleboarding. I also cherish spending quality time with family and friends.

Goreniuk, Annika - Annika is a dedicated and passionate figure skating coach who has been involved in the figure skating world for 17 years. Annika began skating at the age of 5 and developed a deep love for the sport through years of training, testing, and performing. One of the most important accomplishments in her skating career included achieving Skate Canada's Triple Gold status in Skills, Dance, and Artistic. Annika's passion for the sport continues as a coach in the Canskate and Starskate programs. She is a Regional Certified Coach with 6 years of experience with the Canskate program and 2 years of experience with the Starskate program. She is currently attending MacEwan University working on a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology degree in the hopes of becoming a Sports Psychologist in the future. As a coach, Annika emphasizes strong foundational technique, while building confidence and resilience in each skater, helping them grow both on and off the ice. She loves building connections with skaters and their families, no matter which program they are involved in. According to her, seeing skaters dedicate themselves, put in the work, and achieve their goals is one of the most fulfilling parts of coaching.

Nägeli, Sandra - Sandra is a National level coach (level 3 NCCP) with 45 years of experience. She has coached skaters to achieve close to 300 Gold Tests in all Skate Canada disciplines. She has coached Skate Canada Sectional level Champions, and has had Challenge and National Competitors in Singles and Ice Dance. She believes in the importance of all skating disciplines (freeskate, dance, skills and artistic). Sandra achieved Skate Canada Gold Level in Compulsory Figures, Freeskate, Dance, Skills and Artistic, and also Senior Competitive test. Competitively, as a National level Senior competitor, she was named to the Senior National team, competing for Canada at International level, 1978/79/80. These accomplishments were highlighted by her invitation to compete at Skate Canada International 1980. She will always be remembered for being one of the best spinners of her time. As a coach Sandra now has a special interest in grassroots edge development for all disciplines. She has participated many times over her career as a Clinic Conductor for the Skate Alberta Section, as well as developing her own "Creative Edges" workshops. With her background in compulsory figures she offers insight into figure form for skaters and mentoring coaches. She is a Skills and Artistic Gold Level Assessor and Mentor.

Williamson, Della - Della has been involved in the skating world since she was seven years old. As a competitive skater, she especially loved working on her jumps and competed up to the pre-novice level before leaving for university. She has achieved Skate Canada's Triple Gold status in Skills, Dance and Freeskate. Now in her fourth year, she hopes to pursue Physiotherapy school while continuing to advance her coaching career. She values the opportunity to experience skating from a coach's perspective and appreciates the positive impact it can have on young athletes. She is excited to continue expanding her qualifications into the StarSkate coaching level and looks forward to supporting skaters in building confidence, strength, and resilience both on and off the ice.
